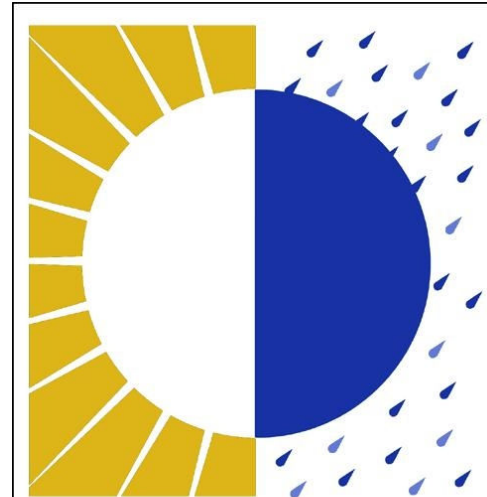

**PILGRIM COMMUNITY SCHOOL** ~ The Pilgrim Community School fall session will run September — November. A **Love Wins** class, led by Craig Peterson, will be held Wednesdays September 20, 27, and October 4 at 5:30 pm. The class will be a discussion-type based on the book by Rob Bell. Books are available at local book stores and on Amazon for about \$10. Bell talks about heaven and hell — who goes and who doesn't — and whether there is a hell in real life.
