### Pastor's Message: ALL ARE WELCOME!!

Dear Friends,

Despite the blizzards and cold winds, spring is coming. Despite our doubts and fears, resurrections happen. We fear that life will never be the same after Covid. And it won't be, but it will continue. We fear that the church people who have been cautious about joining us for worship may not rejoin our community when it's safe to do so. But darkness and doubt only have the last word if we let it. I'm thinking of doubting Thomas this morning. I wonder how his friends felt when he said, "I don't trust you". I wonder how the women felt when they rushed back from the tomb and the men didn't trust them? The question of trust is an everyday issue for us right now. Do we trust the medical establishment? Do we trust the Democrats, the Republicans, the news, our friends and relatives? Are we so fearful that we trust, like Thomas, only ourselves?

The word that keeps coming to mind is 'discernment'. It's an old religious word that means the process of sorting out which spirit is the Holy Spirit and which spirit is the pretender, the deceiver, the enemy of God? When the darkness takes over we live in fear, self-blame, guilt, anger and mistrust of just about everything. When the Holy Spirit is our guide, the power of light breaks through doubt and fear and confusion, and low self-worth. The message of God is always about life, not death; hope not fear. That's an easy way to tell the voices in your head apart. Jesus blessed the disciples in the upper room with the Holy Spirit. What happened? Those people who had been hiding in fear, burst out of the doors and started proclaiming the Gospel. You know the story of the early church...the exciting adventures in the book of Acts. I think it's my favorite book in the Bible because it shows God partnering with ordinary people to call the new church into life. That's a bit like where we are, isn't it?

Now is the time to focus on what is possible with God's help to serve and witness to our community. We have a little window, we don't know how long, before perhaps the new Covid variant will make us cautious again. But for now, please help me: Welcome new members, gather support for Ukraine, welcome our new office administrator, and dream for the future. Please read the newsletter carefully with an eye toward where you can help, in person or from a distance. He is risen! And he is calling us back to life!

**from the Superior Telegram — April 22, 1965**

#### **Pilgrim, Trinity Lutheran churches merger becomes official on Sunday**

Holy Trinity Lutheran Church will terminate its 60-year history on Sunday when its congregation joins Pilgrim Lutheran Church. Dr. Theodore E. Matson, Milwaukee, president of the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan Synod of the Lutheran Church of America, will officiate at the ceremony of the union, to be formalized at the 11 a.m. worship service at Pilgrim Lutheran Church.

The Holy Trinity congregation was organized in 1905 for the purpose of establishing a Lutheran church to serve the community in the English language. The church building was erected in 1909. Its members, during the early years, resided in areas widely dispersed throughout Superior, such as Billings Park, the East End, Allouez and South Superior, but as other foreign language Lutheran churches changed to English, the requirement for a central English language church lessened.

The Rev. Lemoyne Boleman of Poplar has served Holy Trinity as its vice-pastor since November and in coordination with Pastors Chester Johnson and Ronnie Peterson of Pilgrim, and the councils of both churches, has administered the transition affairs. The Holy Trinity congregation has been attending worship services at Pilgrim for the past month.

**also from the Pilgrim's Progress — April 25, 1965**

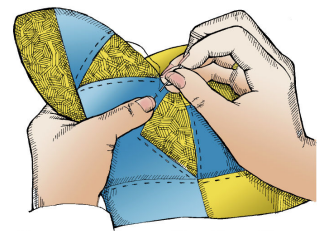

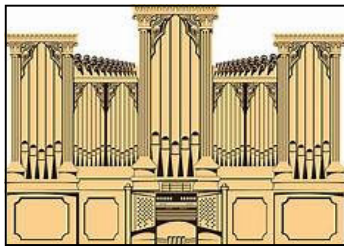
**IT'S TIME TO RESTART THE QUARTERLY QUILTERS (BLANKET BUNCH?)!**

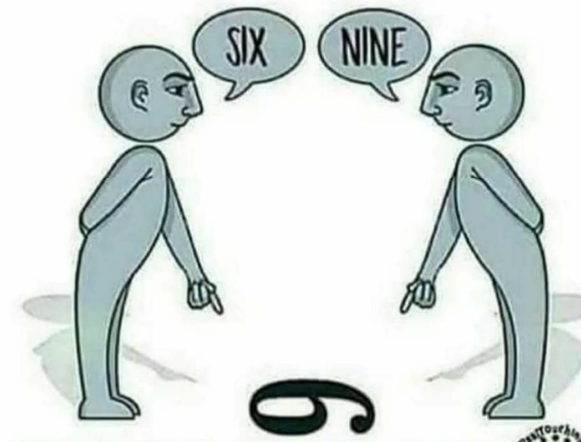
